Turn right onto Corral Canyon Road, go a short distance, turn left onto Solstice Canyon Road (I think thats the road name) and within yards you'll find a parking lot to your left. The park access road (to more parking) is usually closed during week days, but I'll see if I can get it opened for Wednesday.

Time: We'll meet at the parking lot at 9:15 and start the hike 9:30 sharp.
