## MOUNT ISLIP

Trip data:

Distance:	7 miles, round trip
Elevation gain:	1500 feet
Trailhead elevation:	6650 feet
Average slope:	430 ft per mile, 8 % grade
Effort:	Moderate

The hike for July 18, 1990 will be to Islip Saddle to Little Jimmy Campground and Mt. Islip

This is a good hike for this time of year. The elevation will insure that even on the hottest days the hike temperature will be tolerable.

We will see the usual woods and mountains as we ascend a fairly easy upward climb. At 2 1/2 miles we will go through Little Jimmy Campground. There is a small spring, called, appropriately, Little Jimmy Spring, about a quarter of a mile from the campground. It is really just a seep. At the summit is a stone cabin, just the walls, which was the residence of the fire lookout in times past.

From La Canada drive 41 miles up the Angeles Crest Highway, Rte 2, past the old intersection of Rte 2 and Rte 39. Rte 39 is now closed due the road falling off the mountain several years ago. Continue about 1 1/2 miles to the trailhead. Parking is on a wide area of the shoulder

We will start the hike at 9:30 AM.
