MT. WILLIAMSON from Islip Saddle on Angeles Crest Highway
5 m . round trip moderate $1,600^{\prime}$ elevation gain
From the summit of 8,214 ' Mt. Williamson, you get an eagle's eye view of the desert floor 5,000' below, most of all the twisted and folded rocks of Devil's Punchbowl and the San Andreas Rift Zone.

MEETING PLACE--Beside a government building near paddle \#64.10 about 40 m . from La Canada.--The trail to the summit passes through Jeffrev and ponderosa pine. The most spectular view of the country below is from a point $\frac{1}{3} \mathrm{~m}$. NW of the summit on Pleasant View Ridge.
