THE BRIDGE TO NOWHERE

The hike for June 26, 1991 will be up the East Fork of the San Gabriel River to the Narrows and the Bridge to Nowhere.

Trip data:

Distance:	9 miles, round trip
Elevation gain:	1000 feet
Average slope:	222 ft per mile, 4.2% grade
Effort:	Moderate

From Azusa drive up the San Gabriel Canyon Road 10 miles, then turn right on the East Fork road and continue 8 more miles to the East Fork Ranger Station. Park Just below the station. Allow 30 minutes driving time above Azusa.

We will hike up the East Fork to the Narrows, passing remnants of the old East Fork Road that was destroyed in the great flood of 1938. With the destruction of the road a bridge was left which does, indeed, go nowhere. We will cross the creek several times, possibly dampening our feet.

We will start the hike at 9:30 AM.
