Location: Zuma/Trancas Canyons July 14 2010 Hike Leader: Roland Bassett

Directions: The trail head is at the end of Busch Dr. which is about a mile west of Kanan-Dume Road off the PCH.

Hike Description: Dick Battin did this hike 7/25/2000. I have no recollection, perhaps some of you do. The loop marked on the attached map is advertised as being 9.8 miles but looking at the map and scale it doesn't look that long. It also says that there is a 1700 ft. elevation gain but I don't know if that is just the peak or includes all the ups, because after reaching Zuma Edison Road it drops down into the floor of Zuma Canyon and then climbs out of the canyon to the ridge then back down to the heart of the canyon.

As shown on the map there are several less strenuous shorter hikes around the trail head. For the billy goats looking for even more activity you could continue the Zuma Ridge trail all the way to Encinal Canyon Road then return and finish the loop.

It should be apparent by now that this will be a new adventure for some of us!
