DEVIL'S PUNCHBOWL NATURAL AREA

(One of those, ahem, longer drives. Would we were ravens.)

General location: north side of the San Gabriels.

South Bay and Valley: take Highway 14 to Pearblossom Highway/138 then to N6. Orange County: perhaps take the 15 to Pearblossom Highway/138 then to N6.

At the town of Pearblossom, turn on to LONGVIEW/N6.

Orientation: for those coming from Highway 14 look for Longview/N6 on the far side of the town, and turn right.

Turn onto Longview/N6 (and stay on N6 even if name changes) and drive south for 8 miles to the Punchbowl entrance and parking. The trail begins behind the park nature center.

THE HIKE

6-7 miles, 800 to 1200 feet?, to the Devils Chair and return the same way. Plus to add on, an easy one-mile loop from the visitor center into the depths of the Punchbowl, switchbacks gradually down, spending time with some of the taller rock slabs.

Longing for long? Continue another 3 miles past the Devil's Chair to South Fork Campground. Return the same way.

We think the trail to the Devils Chair will be well marked.
