I checked with Caltrans and received this:

IS CLOSED 4.5 MI SOUTH OF ISLIP SADDLE (LOS ANGELES CO) - DUE TO
STORM DAMAGE - MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED TO USE AN ALTERNATE ROUTE

Mickey and I agreed that it would be best to avoid potential problems on SR-39 due to the fire. Therefore an alternate hike was selected.

From La Canada, on the 210, turn north on SR-2, Angeles Crest Highway, to Red Box. At Red Box there are a number of trails. There is Mount Disappointment or a shuttle could be arranged for Switzer's or the Strawberry Peak trail is available to be explored. In fact there are a number of options. When we get there we can make our choices.

This will become an extemporaneous adventure.

Bring an FR radio, plenty of water and a real whistle; not one of those little peewee toys that some of you are carrying. Be Prepared.
