THE HIKE:

This dayhike in the San Gabriel Mountains will start at Icehouse Canyon Resort, at 5000 feet elevation, on the road to Mt. Baldy. Our route will follow the Icehouse Canyon Trail. The trail leads east along the floor of the canyon. The path stays close to the oak and spruce shaded creek and passes some cabins. Brick chimneys and stone foundations are all that remain of other cabins, swept away during the great flood of 1938. After 1.3 miles the trail forks. We will take the "high route", the Chapman Trail, 1.5 miles to Cedar Glen Trail Camp, 1400 feet elevation gain and 2.8 miles from the trailhead.

The Chapman Trail, constructed in 1980, was named for the family that built the Icehouse Canyon resort and numerous cabins in the 1920s. The well-constructed trail heads up Cedar Canyon to Cedar Glen. The cedars were severly scorched by the 1980 Thunder Mountain Fire, but the canyon flora is slowly recovering

DRIVERS:

Harbor Freeway to 91 Freeway to 605 Freeway then East on the 210 Freeway to Foothill Blvd. Then left on Mills Ave. which turns into San Antonio Canyon Road. Icehouse Canyon Resort is 1.5 miles above Mt. Baldy Village.

GOODIES:
