The Pacific Crest Trail passes through black oak groves here and underfoot hopefully the brodiaea, baby blue-eyes and miner's lettuce are blooming. They are there. We will ascend the trail 1,800' to an undistinguishable summit with plentiful trees.---Tigers can take the PCT as far as they want, but my present plan is to eat lunch under one of the large oaks and watch the tigers go.

The driving time from my Culver City home has been only 1½ hours the two recent times I have gone the 70 miles.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Liebre is 19 m. SE of Gorman. From the junction of Hwy. 138 & N2, 4m. E of I-5, drive S on N2 for 2.2 m., then E 4.2 m. N2 to Horse Trail Campground, marked by a paintless pipe with a yellow rope tied securely around it. Turn S, go about 0.1 m. There is a turn around with space for 2 cars, but if there is no other vehicle parked ahead of us, we can park on this spur road. Lacking this ability, we will park on N2 and walk the extra 0.1 m. to the PCT.

REMEMBER the fee for a vehicle in any national forest begins May 24.

I hope to see you on this view-a-plenty experience.
