August 15 -- Three Points to Sulphur Springs -- Jack Robinson

Trailhead Directions:

Drive north on Hwy 2 (Angeles Crest) from the 210 Freeway past the Clear Creek Information Center to Sulphur Springs Road (3N17). This is Three Points and is approximately 2.5 miles past the Chilao Visitor Center turnoff. Turn left and proceed about one hundred feet to the paved parking lot where we will meet for the 9:30 am departure. There is a restroom at the parking area.

The Hike:

From the parking area we will proceed west on the Silver Moccasin Trail about 1.3 miles then proceed on a private road past John Dee Lake about 1.4 miles to an intersection with the PCT. We will have cookies near the lake. If there is a mouse patrol they can turn right at the PCT and proceed 1.7 miles to the parking lot for a 4.4 mile hike. The balance of the hikers turn left and proceed 1.8 miles to the Sulphur Springs Campground. After lunch we will follow the road to the junction with the PCT and return to the parking lot for refreshments.

9.2 miles round trip, 930' elev. change.
