Eagle Spring Loop 8 miles round trip, fairly easy 1100 feet gain and loss

We will meet at the Marvin Braude Mulholland Gateway Park, which is at the southernmost extension of Reseda Blvd. in Tarzana. Plenty of parking space and no fee. We met there for a previous hike.

From the park, we climb south a few hundred yards to Mulholland and turn right (west) on Mulholland. We climb slightly for a quarter mile to a 3-way junction and turn south past a gate onto fireroad 30. This leads to the "Hub" – about 2 miles, where those who want a very short hike can turn around. Or one could continue from the "Hub" immediately to the right on the north tending road (eventually toward the West) to Eagle Rock and then retrace the route. The full hike will, in fact, pass Eagle Rock down to Eagle Junction and then cut back (left) to the east and downhill to Eagle Spring. We can eat lunch near Eagle Spring down in the canyon. From there we continue back up to the "Hub" and return the way we came to the cars (Dick Battin, keep your eyes open).

Several of you have said you would like to see my paintings. Therefore, we will mount up and go to my home, which is very close to the park, and have our refreshments there. I will lead the way so no-one gets lost.
