## Transportation

Depart from Catalina Landing in Long Beach. Take 710 Freeway south into Long Beach. Stay to the left, follow signs to downtown and exit Golden Shore. Turn right at stop sign; follow around to Catalina Express Terminal on the right. Parking in parking structure on the left.

Check in starts at 7:45 AM. Bring a picture ID. Must be through check in and ready to board at 8:30. Depart for Avalon at 8:45. To return we depart Avalon at 5:45 PM for Catalina Landing. Both crossings are less than 1 hour.

For those of you who are spending the night, luggage restrictions, hotel packages, etc., can be found on Catalinaexpress.com/public.

Roundtrip cost is \$38 for seniors; however, there is a \$9.50 discount coupon off the regular price of \$42 good for 4 adults in the Entertainment Book 2002. ## Description

About 10 AM we will proceed to downtown and hike up Avalon Canyon Road 1.2 mile to the Hermit Gulch Trail. At this point one has options to go up Hermit Gulch trail or to proceed to the easier Wrigley Memorial Road trail. Each of the trails is described on the attached map.

The primary hike is 8.1 miles and 1500 ft. elevation gain plus whatever the elevation gain is of the Lone Tree Trail. We will go up the Hermit Gulch Trail, out the Lone Tree Trail and return, 0.8 mile on the Divide Road and return on the Wrigley Memorial Road and the Avalon Canyon Road.

This is hunting season however no hunting is allowed near the hiking trails and the Catalina Conservancy anticipates no problems with our defined hike.
