The Bridge to Nowhere

Mickey Costello will lead the hike for Wednesday, July 8, 2009, up the East Fork of the San Gabriel River to the Narrows and to the Bridge to Nowhere. We will wade the river about 15 times in each direction, (knee-deep water), so expect to get your feet wet. Look for the swan at Swan Rock.

This hike is about 9 miles round trip. The elevation gain is about 1000 feet. The difficulty is moderate.

From Azusa drive up the San Gabriel Canyon road, (SR-39) about 10 miles, then turn right on the East Fork road at the East Fork Bridge. Continue 8 more miles to the parking area at the end of the road. At about 6 or 7 miles avoid the right turn onto Glendora Ridge Road. Allow 30 minutes driving time above Azusa.

We will start the hike at 9:30 AM.
